1. All livestock exhibitors must show proof of liability insurance and sign bottom of entry form with policy numbers and company name
2. All Jr. exhibitors must have entry form filled out and signed by a parent or guardian.
3. Jr. exhibitors are 17 years and under as of January 1st of current year.
4. Jr. exhibitors are forbidden to show or handle stallions on fairgrounds.
5. Approved helmets with harness must be worn by all Jr. riders when mounted and all riders over fences.
6. All entries must be serviceably sound or they will not be judged.
7. First three placings in qualifying classes must show back in championship or forfeit previous winnings.
8. Tack hold will be 3 minutes and should be requested 2 classes ahead.
9. All Morgan Horses shown must be registered with Canadian National Livestock Records, or if under 1 yr. of age must be eligible for registration. Papers must be available upon request. Foreign owned horses must be registered with the appropriate registry.
10. All appliances or devices (chains, rattles, etc.) are prohibited from the fairgrounds.
11. A \$12.00 Roseneath Fair entry fee must be paid by all exhibitors.
12. Entry fee is 15% of prize winnings for entries postmarked on or before September 23. Post entry fees will be 25%. **No entries accepted after 8:30 am day of show.**
13. No cross entry between classes for any horse or pony unless specified.
14. Animals not under sufficient control shall not be allowed to compete.

RULES FOR PONY PULLING CONTEST

1. A person may enter and drive as many teams as he/she likes in each class.
2. A team or horse may draw in one class only.
3. A teamster is allowed two helpers if he so desires.
4. No interference whatsoever by the helpers while horses are drawing, or draw disqualified.
5. Teamsters or helpers are not allowed at horses heads while hitching or drawing.
6. No cursing, swinging lines, beating horses with ends of lines while hitched or drawing.
7. Teamsters and helpers are to stay behind whiffletrees while horses are drawing.
8. Teamsters and helpers are not allowed to touch, push or slap horses with hands.
9. No check slaps allowed.
10. In case of break in harness, time to repair determined by the Judge.
11. Two complete draws of 15 feet required. There will be 2 tries to pull the load 15 feet. The horses while pulling, must stay within the course lines or be disqualified from that try only.
12. Any movement under 4 inches will be considered a chuck if the teamster is trying to hold team and this will not be considered a pull.
13. Two passes in front of the boat will constitute one try.
14. Teamster, upon entering the pull area has 2 minutes to hitch and 4 minutes to complete pull.
15. Any teamster or helper arguing with the judge will automatically be ejected from contest.
16. Once a team has a draw, that teamster remain teamster for balance of the contest.
17. ALL PULLERS MUST SHOW PROOF OF INSURANCE.
18. All teamsters and helpers must be properly dressed for the occasion.
19. All decisions made by the judge are final.
20. Lightweight Class – teams combined girth is 165 inches or less.
21. Heavyweight Class – teams combined girth is more than 165 inches.
22. Entries must be pre-registered & membership paid before participating in the pull.
23. Prize money will be FORFEITED if puller not registered before entering the competition.
24. Any team considered dangerous by the judge /pull committee will be disqualified.
25. Once the team enters the pulling area for the first pull, and if they have blinders on, they must remain on, and if they are open, they must stay that way.

Best Teamster from Heavy Horse – plaque donated **In Memory of Lorne Elder**

Horse Pulling Rules – 27’ 6” Distance Pull – Buckeye Sled

1. Entry furnishing no negative Coggins Test or fiscal year insurance, No pull
2. There shall be no alcoholic beverages used by teamsters, helpers or officials.
3. All teams must be weighed the day of the pull with a halter and loose shank.
4. Middle Class – 3600 lbs and under. Scales open 12 noon and close at 1:00 pm.
5. **BOTH CLASSES PULL TOGETHER.** Two complete draws of 27’ 6” required.
6. **LENGTH OF DRAW IS 27 FEET 6 INCHES. LONGEST DRAW COUNTS, 2 AT-TEMPTS.** A total of 2 ½ minutes will be allowed to complete each draw. **BUCKEYE PULLING SLED** to be used when possible. Pulling sled to be drawn in both directions for two rounds and then only one direction for remainder of pull. On the second hitch, teamsters have the option of taking immediately following the first hitch, where the boat is sitting. If he/she passes and takes the second hitch at the end of the round than the boat can be spotted anywhere on the track as long as there is sufficient side lines left. The pulling sled to be centered between the two side lines. To be eligible for a second hitch a reasonable attempt must be made on first hitch. Side lines must be 18 feet apart.
7. A teamster is allowed two helpers. Teamsters and helpers must remain behind the double tree while the horses are pulling. After completing the first pull, no change in teamster will be allowed, except in the case of injury.
8. A break in harness-the teamster will decide if he keeps the distance or will start over.
9. A run-away team or team out of control automatic elimination, drug test at teamsters expense.
10. A pull will be disqualified:
 - a) if horses step on or over lines or markers
 - b) if horses are beaten, lines are swung, foul language used
 - c) if helpers interfere in any way after horses are hitched
 - d) if teamsters or helpers head the horses while pulling or hitching
 - e) if teamsters or helpers slap, push or touch the horses with hand lines or whiffletrees while in the ring. **NO CHECK SLAPS WILL BE ALLOWED.**
11. Three circle pass in front of boat or anything over a twelve inch chuck is one pull. Any teamster or helper will automatically be ejected from the contest with all winnings forfeited if he argues with the judge, Fairboard, pulling committee or other contestants.
13. **NO CHANGING OF BRIDLES DURING THE PULL.**
14. **DRUG TESTING TO BE ENFORCED:**
 - f) No drugs allowed
 - g) No team or teamster allowed to pull while suspension with any other organization
 - h) Forfeit prize money and placing
 - i) Additional penalty as fair board concerned feel appropriate.
15. Prize money FORFEITED if puller not registered before entering the competition!!!
