#### **Rules Governing Sheep**

For the purpose of the Sheep Classifications an entry shall be interpreted as follows:

1. All entries must be owned by and registered in the name of the exhibitor.
2. All sheep, whether owned by one person or by more than one person (individually or jointly) which are maintained on one farm are considered to be the entry of one exhibitor.
3. Two entries per section per exhibitor.
4. The following breeds must be shown in short fleece (staple less than 1" or 2.54 cm): Border Cheviot, Dorset, Hampshire, Oxford Down, Shropshire, Southdown, Suffolk. Other breeds may be shown in short or full fleece.
5. All entries must be free of all contagious diseases. **Must be 2 or more exhibitors per breed to hold a class.**

### **SECTION: N.B. Rule #6**

1. EWE – “Yearling” (3<sup>rd</sup> pair of temporary incisors must be in place.)  
- Born and bred in Canada.
2. EWE – Lamb (First pair of temporary incisors must be in place.)  
- Born the property of the exhibitor.
3. RAM – “Mature” (3<sup>rd</sup> pair of temporary incisors must be in place.)
4. RAM – Lamb (First pair of temporary incisors must be in place.)  
Born the property of the exhibitor.
5. GET OF SIRE (Born the property of the exhibitor)  
- A group of three animals, first pair of temporary incisors must be in place by the same sire. Both sexes may be represented. (Animals may or may not have been shown in previous classes.)
6. BREEDERS FLOCK (Bred and owned by the exhibitor)  
- A group of four animals. Both sexes to be represented. Each animal in group must have been exhibited in one of the preceding classes. All animals in group to be of one breed.  
- The registration certificate for each respective animal must show the exhibitor as “breeder” and as “owner” – in both cases either as an individual or in partnership. In other words, the exhibitor may be a “joint owner” of the animal and/or the “joint breeder” of an animal.

Therefore the animal must be:

1. owned and bred by the exhibitor, or
2. jointly owned and bred by the exhibitor, or
3. owned and jointly bred by the exhibitor, or
4. jointly owned and jointly bred by the exhibit
